
I want to move my mobile home. What do I need to do?



What is a Tax Authentication Form?

A Tax Authentication is a form which provides proof that all property taxes have been paid. It is used to get a moving permit for your mobile home.

You can obtain a Tax Authentication at the Larimer County Assessor's Office at 200 W. Oak Avenue, in Fort Collins.

The following information will need to be provided:

- 1. The name(s) and address(es) of both the buyer and seller.
- 2. The name and phone number of the mover/moving company (if the home is being moved)
- 3. The legal address to where the home is being moved (park name, county, city, etc.).
- 4. Serial (VIN) number, Year, Make, and size of the mobile home.
- 5. Sales price and sales date.

Authentication forms / move permits are valid for up to 30 days. Should the home be unable to move within the alloted time, a 2nd permit can be issued for \$10.00.

NOTE: If you are moving your mobile home on State highways, there is a separate permit that must be obtained from the Colorado Department of Transportation. (If you have hired a professional mobile home mover, they typically already carry this permit. Check with them first.)
